

Terms and conditions.

Payment.

1. In order to book a course each student should complete and sign a booking form which will be provided. A booking deposit of €150 must be paid by each student when they book a course. This should be sent to the school's bank account when the booking form is being returned.

2. The balance of the payment agreed must be sent at least four weeks before the commencement of the course which the student has booked. Bank details are provided below. Details of a student's family will only be sent to the student when full payment has been received.

Cancellation refund.

A refund of the balance will only be given to a student if they cancel their booking more than two weeks before the commencement of the course they have booked.

The €150 booking deposit will only be refunded if the student cancels more than four weeks before the commencement of the course.

Insurance and health.

EU nationals must bring an EHIC card.

Students are responsible for their own belongings during their stay.

Each student is responsible for any damage he or she may cause to buildings, furniture, fittings, individuals and host family property while registered with Gorey School of English. They are also responsible for their behaviour while they are here in Ireland.

Respect.

We want all our students to enjoy their stay in Gorey. So we ask that all students show respect for all students, teachers, social activity co-ordinators, host family members and individuals while they are here with us. Gorey School of English reserves the right to send home any student whose behaviour is deemed by us to be inappropriate as follows.
